International Military Fencing Championships will be organized for individual events consisting of :

a. Men : Foil, Epee

b. Women : Foil, Epee

c. Military Retired Events : Men Epee , Women Epee

6. Participants :

- Only fencers from active militaries and Military Retired in their country are entitled to participate in this competition.



7. Entries :

- Entry form by number (by event and number).
The entry form (form 1) for all teams, forwarded through the National Fencing Federation/Association (FIE Member), must be received by the Organizing

Committee of the International Military Fencing Championship 2009 (IMFC 2009), not later than 24:00 hours (Jakarta Time), Oct 16 2009.

- Final Entry (by event, name and military rank).
The final entry form (form 2,3,4) for all events, forwarded through the National Fencing Federation/Association , must be received by the Organizing Committee of the International Military Fencing Championship 2009 (IMFC 2009) not later than 24:00 hours (Jakarta Time), Oct 30, 2009. No changes or additional entries will be accepted after this time.

8. Competition Methods :

The fencing competition shall be conducted in accordance with the current statues and rules of the FIE. In case of disagreement in interpretation of the rules, the latest English version shall prevail. The Directoire de Technique shall deal with any unforeseen incidents not covered by the rules.

9. Equipment :

- All equipments and installations shall comply with FIE Rules and Regulations for Competitions.
- The competitor shall bring their own equipments which complies with the FIE Rules and Regulations.

Kindly note it is COMPULSARY for all participants to wear FIE 800N underplastrons. However it is NOT COMPULSARY to wear FIE 800N fencing jackets/breeches.

All equipments must be examined and marked by the organizing committee before the competitions.

10. Competition Management :

The Organizing Committee of International Military Fencing Championship will be responsible for the Organization of the Championship under the guidance of the AIFA.

- *Referee.*

Each country must be accompanied by a number of FIE Referees according to the following formula :

- 1 – 4 Fencers : no referee
- 5 – 9 Fencers : one referee
- 10 or more : two referees

Board and lodging of the participating referees will be paid by the Organizing Committee.

- The Directoire Technique (DT).
The Directoire Technique will be responsible for the technical organization of the competition. The DT consists of only 3 members of different nationalities, of whom one is a representative of the organizing country.

11. Prizes :

Prizes will be awarded to the first eight places of each individual.

a. First Prize.

Gold medal , diploma and grand prize for the winner in each event (US\$ 1.000)

b. Second Prize.

Silver medal. diploma and grand prize for the second place in each event (US\$ 750)

c. Third Prize.

Joint Bronzes medals, diploma and grand prize for the third place in each event (US\$500)

d. Fifth–eight places.

Diploma for the fifth to eight places in each event.

12. Meetings :

The Team Managers meeting and the referees meeting will be held in Jakarta on November 8, 2009.

The detailed scheduled will be announced later.

13. Languages :

The official language for the International Military Fencing Championships is English.

14. Entry Fees, Accommodation & Food :

- The rate of entry fees is US\$ 15.00/person/individual event.
- Food outlets are available around the venues/mall

- The official accommodation is located in
 - Kaiser Hotel , Jakarta with the rate US\$ 75/per person/per day
Including Airport Pickup, Meal (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner), Transportation to/from Venues

Payment for entry fees and accommodation is to be made in cash by 8 November 2009 after the Team Manager's meeting.

16. General Information

- *Currency*
IDR (Indonesia Rupiah). Foreign currency or traveler checks can be exchanged freely at banks, international tourist hotels and the airport. Current exchange rate is approximately IDR 10.500 for USD\$ 1.00. Major credit cards are widely accepted in most places.
