Regulations

Leader of the competition is our fencingmaster Orvar Jönsson

All fencers must be able to present a valid national license.

FIE-rules and SvFF - tournament rules of Sep. 1th 2009 including security regulations.

The mask must have the new type of bib for foil fencing.

Poule systems depending on the number of fencers and then direct elimination.

Formula

Seeding will be based on factors known to the leaders of the competition.

Fee

Euro 15 or SEK 150 per capita or by double start Euro 20 or SEK 200 which can be paid by registration.

Weapon and security control

Please note that metal vest and the mask are to be checked and given an inspection mark in advance.

Inspection starts at 07.30 on Saturday and Sunday and is also open on Friday 18.00 – 20.00

Weapons and security (all equipment incl. clothes) will be checked on the piste by the referee.

Referees

1 - 4 starts = 0 refereedays	21 – 24 starts	5 refereedays
5 - 8 starts = 1 refereedays	25 – 28 starts	6 refereedays
9 -12 starts = 2 refereedays	29 - starts	7 refereedays
13 -16 starts = 3 refereedays		
17 -20 starts = 4 refereedays		

Every club - Swedish or foreign – with five starts or more must also send referee(s)

A fine of Euro 100 or SEK 1000 must be paid on the day of the competitions - before starting - for every referee that a club is unable to present in accordance with the stipulations above.

The names and competence (e.g. FIA) and weapon of the referees are to be stated in connection with the entries on the 1th April at the latest.

Cafeteria

Beverages, sandwiches etc. will be sold during competition hours.

Fencing equipment for sale

Entry

Please send us your entries by e-mail as early as possible. We must have them on **the 1th of April** at the very latest. Later entries will - if possible - be accepted. In that case the fee will however be doubled.
